# APPENDIX-15

# **Grievance Redressal Mechanism for Students and Faculty**

### 1) Grievance Redressal Mechanism for Students

In order to provide opportunities for redressal of certain grievances of students already enrolled in any institution, as well as for those seeking admission to such institutions, AICTE has notified All India Council for Technical Education (Redressal of Grievance of Students) Regulation, 2019 vide F.No.1- 101/PGRC/AICTE/ Regulation/2019 dated 07.11.2019 for establishment of grievance redressal mechanism for all AICTE approved Technical Institutions. Non-compliance of the above Regulations shall call for punitive action.

Guidelines for Establishment of Grievance Redressal Mechanism for students and faculty.

Refer: Redressal of Grievance of Students Regulation, 2019 vide F.No.1-101/PGRC/AICTE / Regulation / 2019 dated 07.11.2019 and **Appendix 6.3.2**.

### 2) Grievance Redressal Mechanism for Faculty / Staff

It is mandatory for all Technical Institutions to address the grievances of faculty/staff members including service matters at the Institution level itself. A Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) for faculty/staff members shall be constituted by each Institution to look into the grievances of the faculty/staff members. The composition of the GRC shall be as follows:

- a) Principal of the Institution as Chairperson
- b) One Senior Professor of the affiliating University as a Member
- c) One official from University or State DTE (Directorate of Technical Education) (to be nominated by DTE/University Vice Chancellor) as a Member
- d) One Senior Faculty (not below Associate Professor) as Member.
- A complaint from an aggrieved faculty/staff member relating to the institution shall be addressed to the Chairperson, Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC).
- ii. The GRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the concerned DTE or University and a copy thereof to the aggrieved faculty/staff member, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the complaint.
- iii. In case faculty/staff is not satisfied with the decision of Grievance Redressal Committee, they may appeal to the concerned affiliating University/State DTE (in case of diploma institute) for redressal of their grievance.

The University level or DTE level Grievance Redressal Cell established by the University or DTE shall address such grievances and settle the matter at State/University level.

An Institution shall furnish, prominently, on its website, all relevant information in respect of the Grievance Redressal Committee(s) coming under its purview.

# APPENDIX-12

# **Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging**

In view of the directions of the Honorable Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295 of 2006 dated 16-05-2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08-05-2009, to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 23 read with Section 10 (b), (g), (p) and (g) of AICTE Act, 1987, the All India Council for Technical Education has notified Regulations for prevention and prohibition of ragging in AICTE approved Technical Institutions vide No. 37-3/ Legal/ AICTE/ 2009 dated 01.07.2009 available on AICTE Web-Portal http:// www.aicte-india.org/ anti.htm>download. All AICTE approved Technical Institutions have to comply with the provisions made in the above Regulations. Any violation of above AICTE Regulations for the prevention and prohibition of ragging, shall call for punitive action against erring Institutions as per the provisions made in the above said Regulations.

The Institutions shall have to step up Anti-Ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums:

- · Constitution of Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti Ragging Squad;
- Setting up of Anti-Ragging Cell;
- Installing of CCTV cameras at vital points;
- Anti-Ragging Workshops;
- Updating all Web sites with Nodal Officers complete details, alarm bells etc.;
- Regular interaction and counselling with the students;
- Identification of trouble-triggers;
- Mention of Anti-Ragging warning in the Institution's prospectus and information Booklets/ Brochures shall be ensured; and
- Surprise inspection of hostels, student accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measures which would augur well in preventing/ quelling ragging and any uncalled for behavior / incident shall be undertaken.

Students in distress due to ragging related incidents can call the National Anti-Ragging Helpline No. 1800-180-5522 (24x7 Toll Free) or e-mail: helpline@antiragging.in.

The Institution approved by AICTE may be requested to hold Workshops and Seminars on eradication of ragging in higher Educational Institutions. They may be requested to display Anti Ragging posters at all prominent places such as Admission Centre, Departments, Library, Canteen, Hostel, Common facilities etc. The size of posters should be 8'x6'.

The Institution may be requested to submit an online compliance of Anti-Ragging Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in the Technical Institutions, 2009 at www.antiragging.in.

Institutions may be requested to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year at www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org.

Further, the attention of all the Institutions may also be invited to the Third amendment to UGC Regulations dated 29th June, 2016 expanding the definition of ragging by including the following:

"3(j) Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of color, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic, identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background".

- Conducting inquiries into complaints of ragging and taking appropriate disciplinary actions against the perpetrators.
- Promoting awareness about the consequences of ragging and fostering a culture of mutual respect and tolerance.
- Monitoring the implementation of preventive measures to curb ragging within the college premises.

## Anti-Ragging Measures:

- Ragging in any form, whether physical, mental, or emotional, is strictly prohibited within the college premises.
- Students found guilty of ragging shall face severe disciplinary actions, including suspension or expulsion from the college.
- Regular awareness programs and workshops shall be conducted to educate students about the negative consequences of ragging.
- Adequate security measures shall be implemented to prevent incidents of ragging and ensure the safety of all students.
- Posters are placed at various locations on campus to create awareness among the students.
- The Committee shall maintain strict confidentiality throughout the grievance redressal and anti-ragging processes to protect the identities of the complainants and witnesses.
- This policy shall be reviewed periodically to ensure its effectiveness and relevance.
   Amendments may be made as deemed necessary by the college authorities.

## Registering Grievances:

- Instance of ragging or grievance shall be reported immediately to the Committee or Principal in writing. Anonymous complaints shall also be accepted to ensure the safety of the complainant.
- Grievance boxes are placed at several locations on campus for students to drop their grievances. The committees are responsible for periodically checking these boxes and acting upon the grievance received.
- Additionally, grievances can be registered online through the portal created on the college website.






